Human Services Closing Head Start Program, Senior Centers on Monday, September 19, Due to Inclement Weather

U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS — The Virgin Islands Department of Human Services (VIDHS) Head Start Program advises the community that Head Start classrooms will be closed to students across the territory on Monday, September 19, while staff completes assessments and prepares for the resumption of classes on Tuesday, September 20, 2022.

Additionally, Richmond Senior Center on St. Croix, Strive Senior Center on St. Thomas and the Adrian Senior Center on St. John will remain closed due to inclement weather.
